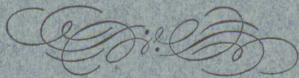


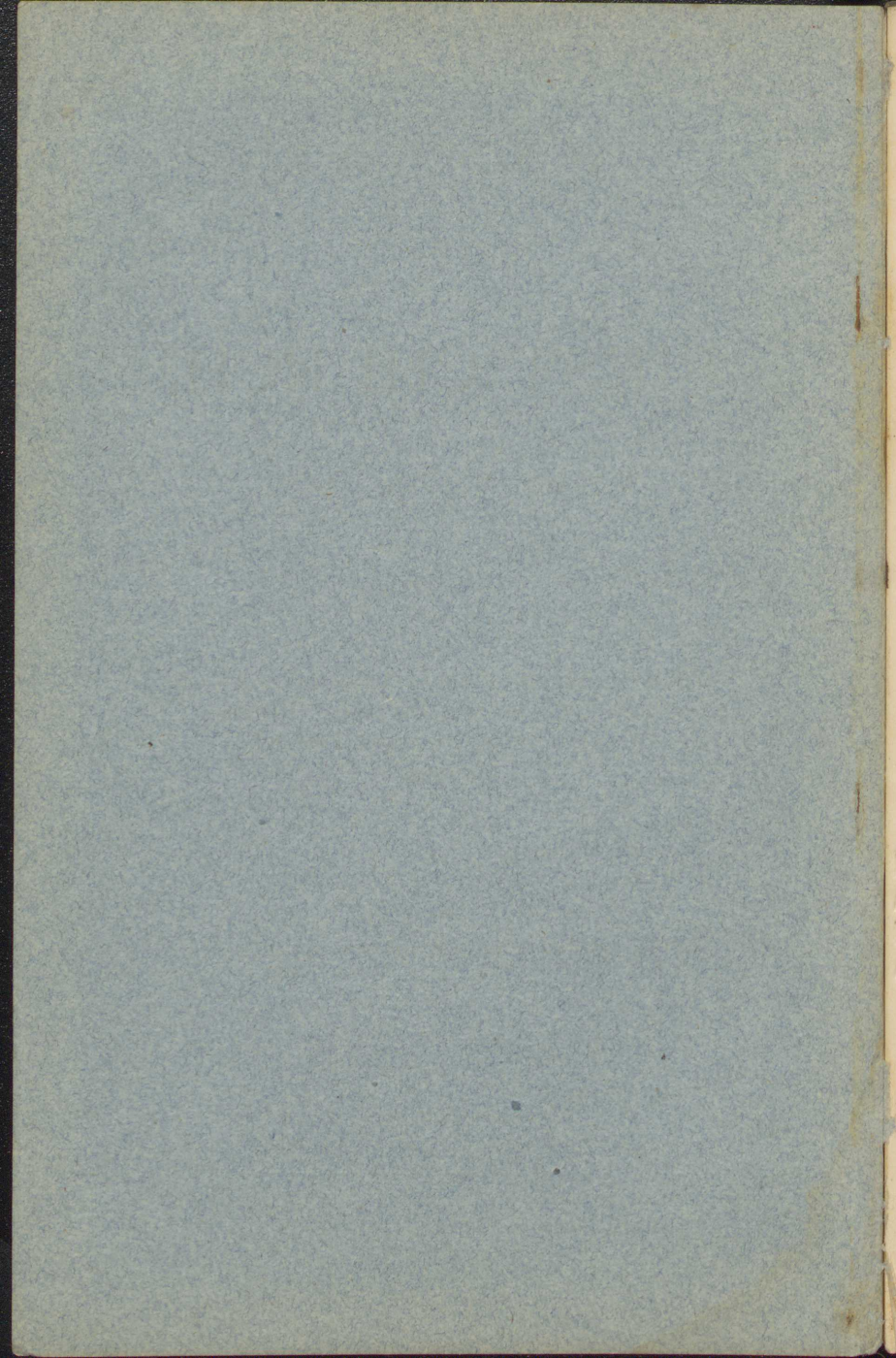

Historical Sketch.

Nutfield, part of which is now Derry, was first settled April 11, 1719, by a colony of sixteen Scotch Presbyterians, with their families, from the north of Ireland. The first sermon preached in the town was by Rev. James MacGregor, (afterwards their first Pastor,) April 12, under a large oak, on the east side of Beaver Pond, from Isaiah, xxxii, 2. "Then," says the historian, "for the first time did this wilderness and solitary place, over which the savage tribes had for centuries roamed, resound with the voice of prayer and praise, and echo to the sound of the Gospel."

This church was the first Presbyterian church in New England, the old church in Long Lane, (now Federal St.,) Boston, not being formed till some time after. The first meeting house was built in 1721, in accordance with the following vote passed at the general Town meeting, held Jan. 11, of that year. "Voated, that a meetinge house shall be built in this town as speedely as may be, and that the above said house shall be fifty feet in length, forty-five feet broad, and so high as may be conveneant for one set of galeryes."

Here the people worshiped nearly fifty years, till in 1769, a new house was erected a few rods south of the old site. This is said to have equalled, if it did not surpass, most of the meeting houses of that day. With the exception of twenty-four feet added to its length, and a new steeple, its general external appearance is unchanged. In 1845 the house was remodelled internally, so as to afford not only a spacious auditorium above, but a Parish Hall and Vestry below, besides several smaller rooms. Occupying one of the most elevated spots in town, it attracts the eye for miles. As a sainted Pastor has said, "its location evinces the wisdom and taste of the early settlers, and around this spot, where the first altar was reared, the most hallowed associations will ever cluster in the breasts of their descendants."

This church has been among the strongest in the denomination. At a communion season in 1723, only three years after its formation, there were one hundred and sixty communicants. The next year there were two hundred and thirty members.

At a sacrament in 1734, fifteen years after the settlement of the town, there were present *seven hundred* communicants. This must have included, however, many non-resident members and friends.

The names of the eleven successive pastors, with the length of their terms of service, are given further on. Six have died, *all of whom repose in the old grave-yard near the meeting house, surrounded by most of their flocks*;—a fact probably not true of any other New England town, which has been settled so long.

Several swarms have gone out from the old hive. In 1739 a company was dismissed to form the church of the West Parish, (Presbyterian,) in Londonderry. In 1797, the Third Society (Congregational,) was organized in the East Parish. In 1837 forty more were dismissed to form the First Congregational Church, in Derry Village. In 1809, however, the Third Society re-united with the mother Church, forming what is now known as the First Church, in Derry. The joint society formally adopted certain "articles of agreement," June 11, 1810. During the pastorate which immediately followed, of that zealous servant of Christ, Rev. Edward L. Parker, the church was unusually prospered. Mr. P. spent his life in serving this people, and after forty years of earnest labor, was suddenly stricken down by death on his return from a third service, in an outlying district, Sabbath afternoon, July 14, 1850. As illustrations of the fruits of his faithful labors, at the January communion in 1825, thirty-six were added to the church; in October, 1831, thirty-three were added, and in May, 1838, *ninety-six* were received.

Since Mr. Parker, the pastorates have been comparatively brief. Most of the old pillars of the church have been removed. "The chariot of Israel and the horsemen thereof!" To whom shall this ancient church look for the men to take the places of those who are fallen? "Nevertheless," we believe, "the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal,

The Lord knoweth them that are His."

Form of Admission.

The minister shall begin by saying ;

The following persons, either coming to us by letter from other churches, or, having given good evidence of their christian character, are now to be received to this Church.

The names being read, he shall address them as follows :

DEARLY BELOVED :

You are here before God and these witnesses to confess the Lord Jesus Christ, and to enter into covenant with God and this Church. We trust that you appreciate the solemnity and blessedness of this privilege, and that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it till the day of Jusus Christ.

THE FOLLOWING IS OUR

Confession of Faith.

I. We believe that there is but one God, the sole Creator, Preserver, and moral Governor of the Universe; a being of infinite power, knowledge, wisdom, justice, goodness and truth; the self-existent, independent and unchangeable fountain of good; that there are in the unity of the Godhead, a trinity of persons, Father, Son and Holy Ghost; that these three persons are in essence one, and in all divine attributes equal.

Deut. VI, 4; John I, 3; Col. II, 3; Jas. I, 17; Matt. xxviii, 19; 2 Cor. XIII, 14.

II. We believe that the scriptures of the old and new Testament were given by the inspiration of God; that they are profitable for doctrine, contain a complete and harmonious system of divine truth, and are our only perfect rule of doctrinal belief and religious practice.

Ps. XIX, 7, 8; 2 Tim. III, 16. 2 Pet. I, 21; John XVII, 17.

III. We believe that the first parents of our race were originally holy in the image of God; that they fell from their original state by voluntarily transgressing the divine command; and that in consequence of this first apostacy, the heart of man in his natural state is enmity against God, fully set to do evil, dead in trespasses and sins.

Gen. I, 26, 27; II, 16, 17; III, 6, 7; Job XIV, 4; xxv, 4; Ps. LVIII, 3; Gal. v, 17; Rom. VIII, 7.

IV. We believe that Christ the Son of God, equal with the Father, has by his obedience, suffering and blood, made infinite atonement for sin ; that he is the only Redeemer of sinners, and that all who are saved will be indebted altogether to the sovereign grace of God through this atonement.

John III, 16 ; Phil. II, 6, 7, 8 ; Rom. III, 24, 25 ; Ephes. I, 7 ; I John IV, 10 ; Acts IV, 12 ; Ephes. II, 8.

V. We believe that those who embrace the gospel were chosen in Christ to salvation before the world began ; and that they are saved not by works of righteousness, which they have done, but according to the distinguishing mercy of God, by the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost.

Ephes. I, 4, 5, 11 ; 2 Thess. II, 13 ; Gal. III, 11 ; Titus III, 5 ; I John IV, 19.

VI. We believe that for those who once believe in Christ, there is no condemnation, but they will be kept by the mighty power of God through faith unto salvation.

Rom. VIII, 1 ; John x, 28, 29 ; Phil. I, 6 ; I Cor. I, 8, 9.

VII. We believe that there will be a general resurrection of the bodies both of the just and of the unjust ; that all mankind must one day stand before the judgment seat of Christ, to receive a sentence of just and final retribution, according to their respective works.

John v, 28, 29 ; Acts XXIV, 15 ; 2 Cor. v, 10 ; Rev. XX, 12.

VIII. We believe that Christ has a visible Church in the world into which believers and their seed are introduced by baptism.

Matt. XVI, 18 ; Acts II, 47 ; IX, 31 ; II, 39 ; XVI, 15.

Do you thus profess and believe ?

Then the minister shall address those who were baptized in infancy as follows.

You, who in childhood were dedicated to God in baptism, by believing parents, do you now accept their act, with the obligations and privileges involved, as your act, and declare your belief that the regeneration thereby symbolized, has been wrought in you by the Holy Spirit ?

To the others, if any, he shall say,

You, who trust your hearts have been renewed, but who have not received the outward seal of the covenant, will now be baptized.

The candidates kneeling, baptism shall be administered and a short prayer offered, after which the minister proceeds :—
And now you do cordially enter into this

Covenant of Grace.

You do now in the presence of God, angels, and men, avouch the Lord Jehovah, Father, Son and Holy Ghost, to be your God, the Supreme object of your affection, and your chosen portion forever. You cordially acknowledge the Lord Jesus Christ in all his mediatorial offices, Prophet, Priest and King, as your only Saviour and final Judge ; and the Holy Ghost as your comforter, sanctifier and guide.

You humbly and cheerfully devote yourself, soul and body to God in the everlasting covenant of his grace ; consecrate all your powers and faculties to his service and glory, and promise through the help of divine grace, without which you can do nothing,

that you will give diligent heed to his word and ordinances and to the motions of his Spirit; that you will seek in all things the honor of his name and the interest of his Kingdom; and that henceforth denying ungodliness and wordly lust, you will live soberly, righteously and godly in this present world.

Those who are to join by letter will now enter, with those already before us, into the

Church Covenant.

You do cordially join yourself to this as a true Church of Christ, unreservedly engaging to submit to its discipline, so far as it is conformable to the rules of the gospel; and you solemnly covenant to walk with its members in love, meekness, watchfulness, circumspection, sobriety and faithfulness.

Thus you covenant, promise and engage.

We then, the members of this Church,

Here the members will rise :

affectionately receive you to our Christian fellowship. We welcome you, in the name of our common Lord, to a share in the duties, privileges and glories of His Church. We now pledge to you our love, our sympathy, our counsel and our prayers.

And now, beloved, remember that you are fellow-citizens with the saints and of the household of God. Let your constant prayer be that Christ may dwell in your hearts, that you may be rooted and grounded in love. The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine upon you,

and be gracious unto you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace.

Now unto Him that is able to keep us from falling, and to present us faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, to the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power; both now and forever. Amen.

Baptism of Children.

(This Church regards it as the privilege of believing parents to consecrate their infant children to God in Baptism. This may be done at any time in connection with public worship, notice having previously been given to the minister.)

Jesus saith: Suffer little children to come unto me.

(The parents shall present themselves, with their children, before the pulpit, when the minister shall address them saying:)

Dearly Beloved: You present yourselves here to consecrate your child unto God. You rely upon the word of His covenant that He will be a God to His people, and to their children after them; and you promise that you will faithfully endeavor to bring up this child in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, so that he may be led, through Christ's grace, to own this covenant himself, in due time.

This you truly and heartily engage?

(The parents shall assent by bowing.)

(Then the minister shall baptize the child, saying and using only the Christian names:)

———, I baptize thee into the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.

(After which he shall offer a short prayer.)
